FBGA representative assists Independent Selection Panel regarding the NCF Commissioners

The NCF is to be hosted by the Mental Welfare Commission (MWC). It will be run by a Head and at least two other members. These members will be appointed by Scottish Ministers through a public appointments process. This is an independent, fair and open process overseen by the Commissioner for Ethical Standards in Public Life. The Deputy Director responsible for the Scottish Government Survivor Scotland Strategy, Maureen Bruce, will chair the NCF Selection Panel on behalf of Scottish Ministers. Graham Forbes, Chair of the MWC, will also be a member. At the request of the Minister for Public Health, a third member of the Selection Panel with direct experience of institutional care as a child to this role.
